REASONS TO CONSIDER

International Growth Opportunities

Low-cost benchmark exposure to the growth of leading companies across diverse industries in the EAFE region, that have demonstrated strong growth potential.

High-Income Potential

EACC seeks to generate additional income through covered call writing, which historically produces higher yields in periods of volatility.1

Monthly Distributions

EACC is designed to provide a consistent monthly income along with potential long-term capital growth.

INVESTMENT OBJECTIVE

EACC seeks to provide, to the extent possible and net of expenses: (a) exposure to the performance of an index of large and mid-cap securities across developed markets including countries in Europe, Australasia and the Far East, excluding the U.S. and Canada (currently, the MSCI EAFE Index); and (b) monthly distributions of dividend and call option income. To mitigate downside risk and generate income, EACC will employ a dynamic covered call option writing program.

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


TOP SECTOR ALLOCATIONS (%)

DEFINITIONS

Annualized Distribution Yield: The most recent regular distribution (excluding additional year end distributions) annualized for frequency, divided by current NAV.

Management Expense Ratio: Management expense ratio ("MER") is based on total expenses, including sales tax, (excluding commissions and other portfolio transaction costs) for the stated period for each ETF and is expressed as an annualized percentage of each ETF's daily average net asset value during the period. Out of its management fees, the Manager pays for such services to the ETF as investment manager compensation, service fees and marketing.

Net Assets: The value of all assets, less the value of all liabilities, at a particular point in time. (Includes all classes of this ETF.)

Risk Rating: Risk Rating is based on how much the ETF's returns have changed from year to year. It doesn't tell you how volatile the ETF will be in the future. The rating can change overtime. An ETF with a low risk rating can still lose money.

12-Month Trailing Yield: The yield an investor would have received if they had held the ETF over the last twelve months stated as a percentage of the net asset value per unit on the last business day of the most recent month-end.

Index 12-Month Trailing Yield: Where the Index yield is not provided directly from the index provider the weighted average trailing yield of index constituents (based on the sum of their trailing dividend yields over the previous 12 months divided by the price at the close of the last business day of the last month end) has been used. Gross or net dividend amounts are used based on the local market convention

Current Index Yield: Where the Index yield is not provided directly from the index provider the weighted average yield of index constituents (based on the sum of the indicated dividend yield [defined as the most recently announced dividend amount, annualized based on the dividend frequency, then divided by the market price as at the close of the last business day of the last month end] of all index constituent securities) has been used. Gross or net dividend amount is used based on market convention.
